## **Consumer Disclosures**

#### **Graduation Rates for 2019**

Of the 31 students in the BARBER/STYLIST 1800 CLOCK HOUR PROGRAM and of the 2 students in the BARBER/STYLIST for LICENSED COSMETOLOGIST 1000 CLOCK HOUR PROGRAM who were scheduled to graduate, 69.70%\*(23 students total) graduated within 150% of the permitted completion time.

#### **Licensure and Placement Rates for 2019**

The licensure rate was 95.65%\* of those students who completed and sat for the Ohio State Cosmetology and Barber Board Licensure Exam.

Of those who completed, the official placement rate was 78.26%.\*

Note: Graduates who have not taken or passed the licensure exam are included in the placement rate (there was 1 in 2019)

#### **Graduation Rates for 2018**

Of the 28 students in the BARBER/STYLIST 1800 CLOCK HOUR PROGRAM and of the 2 students in the BARBER/STYLIST for LICENSED COSMETOLOGIST 1000 CLOCK HOUR PROGRAM who were scheduled to graduate, 66.67%\*(20 students total) graduated within 150% of the permitted completion time.

### **Licensure and Placement Rates for 2018**

The licensure rate was 100%\* of those students who completed and sat for the Ohio State Cosmetology and Barber Board Licensure Exam.

Of those who completed, the official placement rate was 75.00%.\*

Note: Graduates who have not taken the licensure exam are included in the placement rate (there were 3 in 2018)
