Graduation Rates for 2021

Of the 55 students in the BARBER/STYLIST 1800 CLOCK HOUR PROGRAM and in the BARBER/STYLIST for LICENSED COSMETOLOGIST 1000 CLOCK HOUR PROGRAM who were scheduled to graduate, 54.55%*(30 students total) graduated within 150% of the permitted completion time.

Licensure and Placement Rates for 2021

The licensure rate was 85.71%* of those students who completed and sat for the Ohio State Cosmetology and Barber Board Licensure Exam.

Of those who completed, the official placement rate was 76.67%.*

Note: Graduates who have not taken or passed all parts of the licensure exam are included in the placement rate (there were 6 in 2021)

Graduation Rates for 2020

Of the 33 students in the BARBER/STYLIST 1800 CLOCK HOUR PROGRAM and in the BARBER/STYLIST for LICENSED COSMETOLOGIST 1000 CLOCK HOUR PROGRAM who were scheduled to graduate, 51.52%*(17 students total) graduated within 150% of the permitted completion time.

Licensure and Placement Rates for 2020

The licensure rate was 82.35%* of those students who completed and sat for the Ohio State Cosmetology and Barber Board Licensure Exam.

Of those who completed, the official placement rate was 70.59%.*

Note: Graduates who have not taken or passed all parts of the licensure exam are included in the placement rate (there were 3 in 2020)
